

KPTL RECEIVED NEW ORDERS OF RS 809 CRORE

Mumbai, May 25, 2016: Kalpataru Power Transmission Limited (KPTL), a leading global EPC player in the power & infrastructure contracting sector has secured new orders/notification of approx. Rs 809 crores. The details are as follows:

- Turnkey project (*under JV*) for construction of 400 KV transmission line in East Africa of Rs 522 crores (*KPTL share*)
- Two transmission line supply projects for Vindhyaachal - Jabalpur Transmission line of approx. Rs 176 crores from Powergrid Jabalpur Transmission Limited (a wholly owned subsidiary of PGCIL)
- Turnkey project for construction of 220 KV and 132 KV substations, transmission lines and feeder bay of Rs 111 crore from Madhya Pradesh Power Transmission Company Limited
